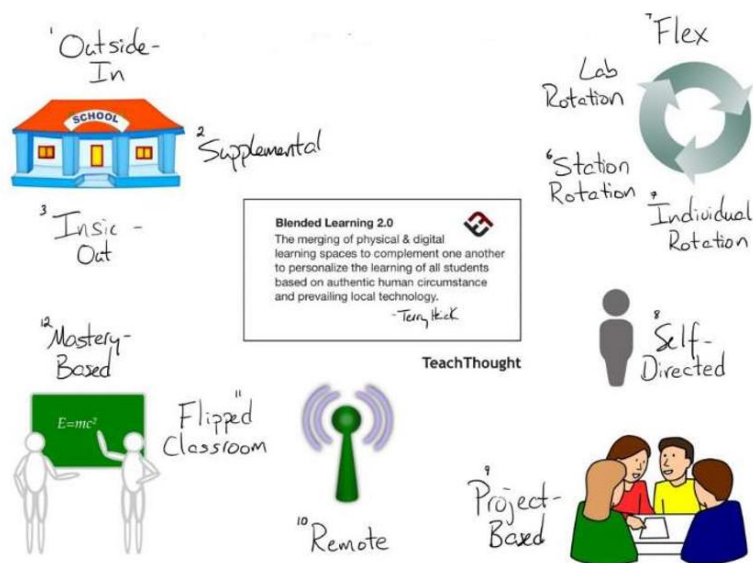

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## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Blended Learning Environment & the LMS Platform developed is develop and hosted by the Coordinating Institution (Frederick University) and will be accessible by all partner universities through the official ICTeEfS Website (<http://icteefs.frederick.ac.cy/>). It will be largely used for distance learning support along with the Online Community of Practice (OnCoP). Blended Learning is a method of personalized learning that combines traditional face-to-face instruction with digital learning that allows the student to benefit from control over pace and learning path. Blended Learning is the method of effectively combining online teaching with traditional offline, face-to-face instruction in order to provide the learner with a deeper, more meaningful learning experience. The following model shows the multiple methods and channels that constitute a blended learning environment. There will also be linked to the ICTeEfS Toolkit accessible at <http://icteefs.frederick.ac.cy/main-icteefs-toolkit/about/>. The ICTeEfS e-Toolkit is open source that is freely accessible without registration. However, the LMS (Learning Management System) of the Blended Training Environment needs registration for accessibility (<https://learn.frederick.ac.cy/login/index.php>). All these systems and tools will be supported by the ICT Labs to be developed in each partner university. The LMS will be also transferred/linked to each partner University at the phase of ICTeEfS implementation phase.



## The ICTeEfS e-Toolkit, Online Community of Practice and Blended Training Management System

At the first page of the Website there is a tab that give access to the blended training environment. It is a restricted area to teaching staff involved in the ICTeEfS project. During the pilot phase there will be organized to establish similar LMS in each of our partners' Faculties of Education in order to support the ICT teacher coordinators in-service training program. To this end, the current LMS will serve largely for training purposes and prepare the staff to this transition.




As pointed earlier, access to the ICTeEfS e-Toolkit is freely accessible through the Website, while access to the Online Community of Practice and the LMS of the Blended Training Environment are restricted only to the ICTeEfS staff.

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
